Award Criteria

The Citizen of the Year Award is meant to recognize individuals, not for particular year of volunteer service, but rather to recognize a person who has performed outstanding and dedicated volunteer service to the community and/or towards helping others over time separate from their employment responsibilities. The individual nominated must have provided such volunteer service in the Waynesville-St. Robert area.

Nominations for the Citizen of the Year Award will be accepted from any Chamber member. The nomination process shall be made public by the call for nominations through utilizing the local newspapers, radio stations, and Chamber newsletter. A one-page letter outlining the candidate's qualifications and experience will comprise the formal nomination form along with a brief summary of the nominee and a photo.
