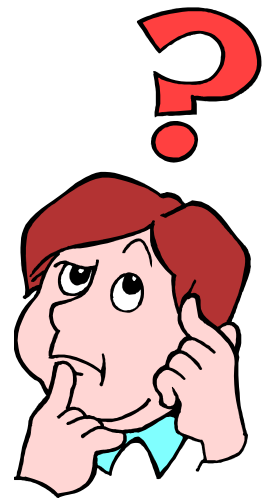
Ft. Leonard Wood has over **13 Million** Square Feet of Buildings & Structures
